Don't Forget....

- ◆ Closet bolts (for fastening your toilet to the floor)
- ◆ Mini hacksaws (for cutting your bolts to length)

What does that mean????

When shopping for plumbing fixtures, it is helpful to be on top of the terms used to describe the features of an item. Hopefully this glossary will help!



Elongated: The bowl of the toilet is more oval allowing for more comfort if room allows in your bathroom. The bowl averages 18-1/2" long. Don't forget to ask for an elongated seat too!

Round: standard toilet

bowl shape . Averages around 16-1/2" long.

Lavatory: this is the sink

ComfortFit: Also known as handicap. This toilet sits about 17" from the floor instead of 14-1/2" to 15", offering more comfort for the elderly as well as ease for those in wheelchairs.

Rough-in: The amount of distance from the wall to the hole in the floor. 10" is standard, but 12"

and 14" is also used. Your tank will be based on your rough-in measurement. The bowl stays the same.

Centers: on sinks, you need to know if your faucet has a 4" center or an 8" center so that your sink matches up with your faucet. Center is the distance between your hot and cold levers.

Right-hand / Left Hand: A tub will have openings for the drain either on the right hand side or the left hand side.
