It has three different switch options and has a patented vertical magnetic float specifically designed for smaller

The **Zoeller M57** is comparable to the Liberty VMF257. The M57's 1 phase, 1/3 HP motor is available in 115 volt or 230 volt. It also has an all cast iron body and a 1-1/2" discharge that can handle 1/2" solids. It is available in Automatic (M57) and Non-Automatic (N57).

Did You Know????

There are many choices when it comes to drainage pipe. Which pipe is the best for you? It all depends on the application you are dealing with. Let's look at simple drainage in landscaping:

- **Single or Double Wall?** Depends on if you're driving over the area with a car. Double Wall needs to be buried at least 18" if it will be driven over.
- **Holes or No Holes?** Personal preference. French drains will use the holes and sock to keep debris from filtering into the pipe.

Solid will drain to the street or other outlet.

- **Corrugated or S&D?** Corrugated allows flexibility in movement. You can make curves and turns without use of elbows. S&D is rigid and needs fittings to make any turns. Both types come with or without holes.
- **S&D or DWV?** S&D pipe can NOT withstand pressure of any kind. The DWV pipe Greensboro Pipe carries has a dual S40 rating up to 6", so it can carry pressure from a pump.

- **Plastic, Concrete or Metal?** Once again, your choice. Concrete and metal are primarily used for driveways because of their strength. Plastic is mainly used when weight is not an issue. On the whole, Corrugated metal pipe is the least expensive, followed by Double Wall black corrugated and finally concrete.
